Programs Ontario autism families commonly apply for. Tick when started, then when approved.

PROVINCIAL — CHILD UNDER 18

☐ **Ontario Autism Program (OAP) — register at AccessOAP**

accessoap.ca · childhood budgets, urgent response, entry to school

☐ **Special Services at Home (SSAH)**

ontario.ca/page/special-services-home · not income-tested

☐ **Assistance for Children with Severe Disabilities (ACSD)**

Income-tested monthly support; same family of forms as SSAH

☐ **Easter Seals Incontinence Supplies Grant**

igprogram.easterseals.org · \$400 (ages 3–5) or \$900 (6–17) / year

☐ **Easter Seals Top-Up Grant (incontinence grant + ACSD)**

Usually opens June–July; Easter Seals emails current grant families

FEDERAL AND CANADA-WIDE

☐ **Disability Tax Credit (DTC) — Form T2201**

Required before an RDSP. See Foundations and Taxes.

☐ **Child Disability Benefit (after DTC, child under 18)**

Paid with the Canada Child Benefit once CRA approves the DTC

☐ **Access 2 card**

access2card.ca · support person admitted free at many venues

AGE 16–18 TRANSITION

☐ **Developmental Services Ontario (DSO) adult intake**

Start before the 18th birthday

☐ **Passport adult funding (after DSO)**

Replaces much of what SSAH covered in childhood

☐ **ODSP planning — talk with a benefits planner first**
